Glenn Beck's American Journey Experience partners with U.S. Department of Education to launch 50-State History Rocks Tour

DALLAS (Dec. 16, 2025) — As America approaches its 250th anniversary, The American Journey Experience is proud to join the America 250 Civics Education Coalition and partner with the U.S. Department of Education, AFPI, and over 40 state and national organizations to recognize excellence in civics education and promote a shared understanding of the principles that shaped the founding and history of our nation.

The America 250 Civics Education Coalition is leading the charge to ensure that America's 250th birthday is not only a celebration of the past, but also a commitment to renewing civic knowledge, civic pride, and the responsibilities of citizenship for generations to come.
